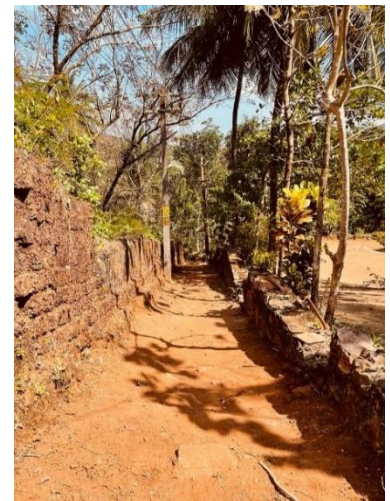


## **12. The Cleaning of the Pavement at Nenmini (28/12/2022)**

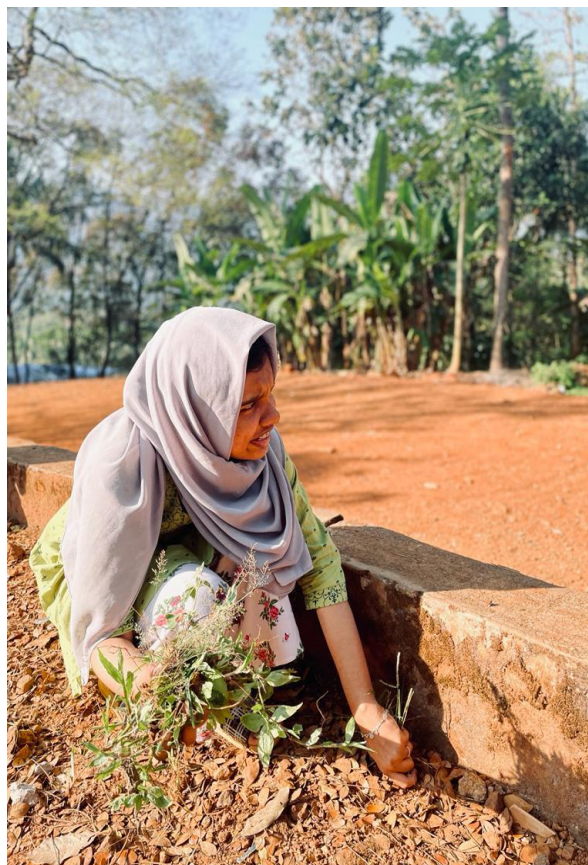


### **13. A Cleanliness Drive in GMLP School, Nenmini. (30/12/2022)**

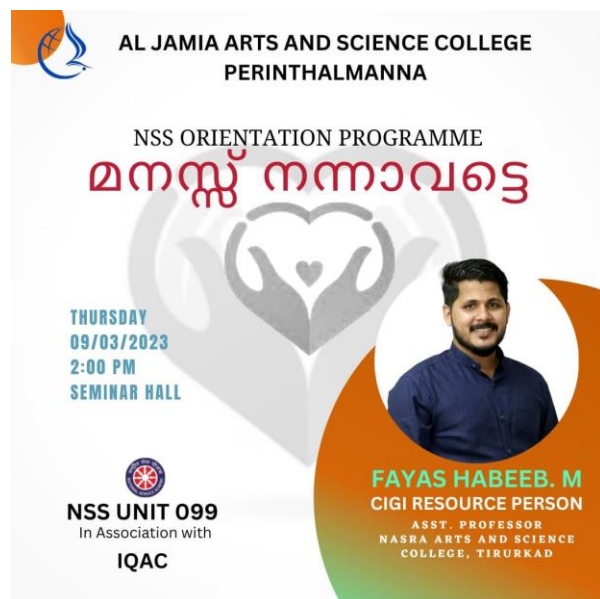
