

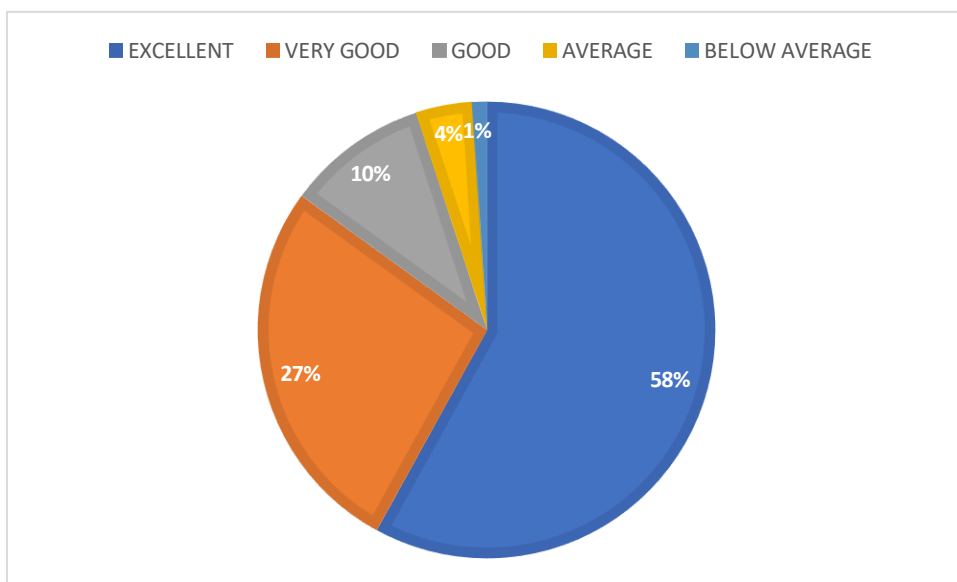


ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2019-20

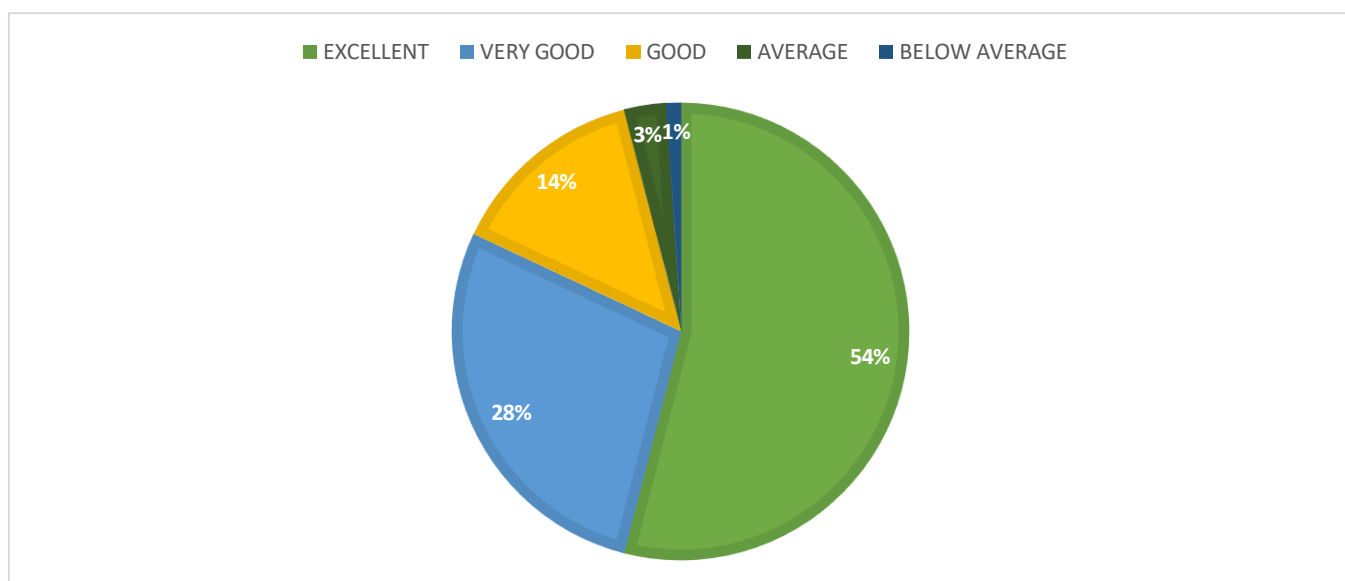
