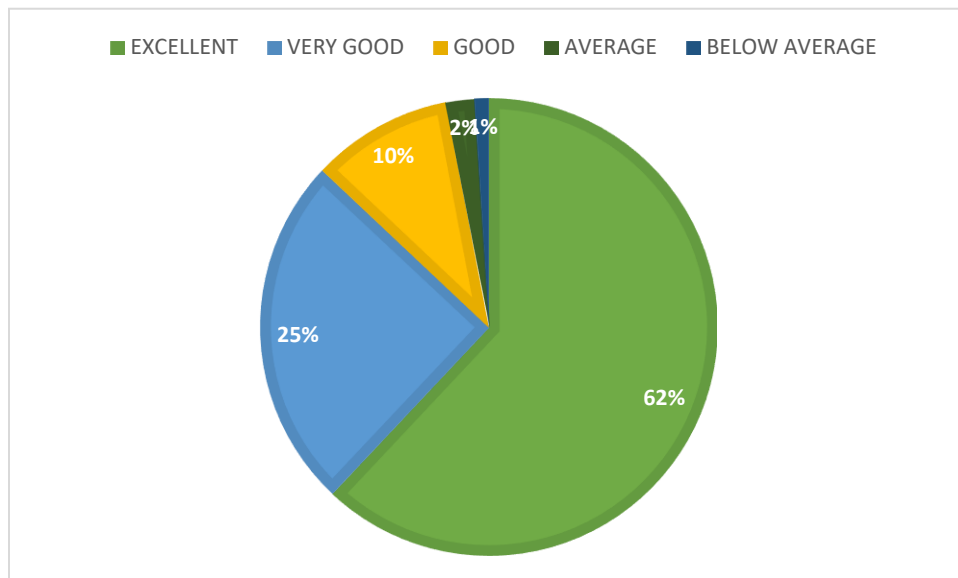

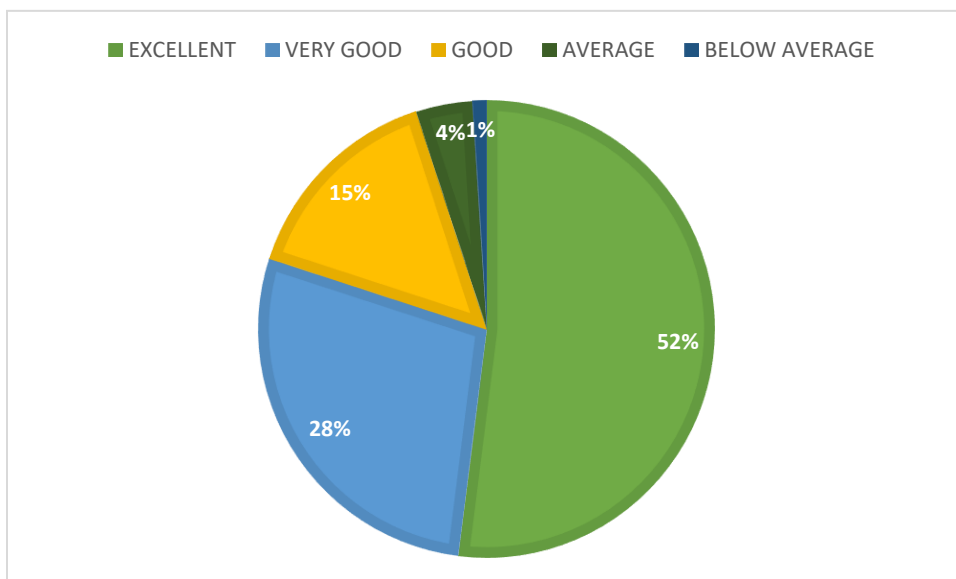

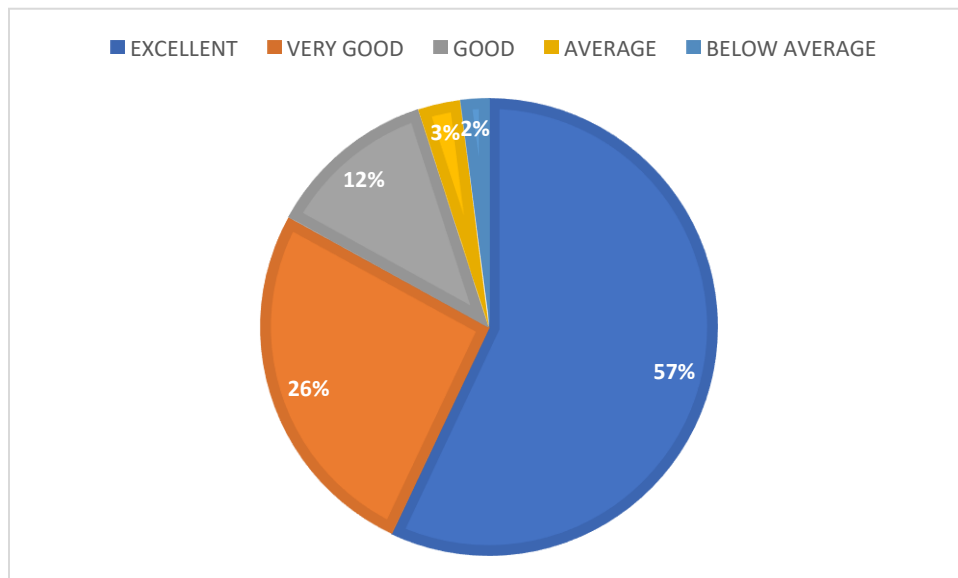

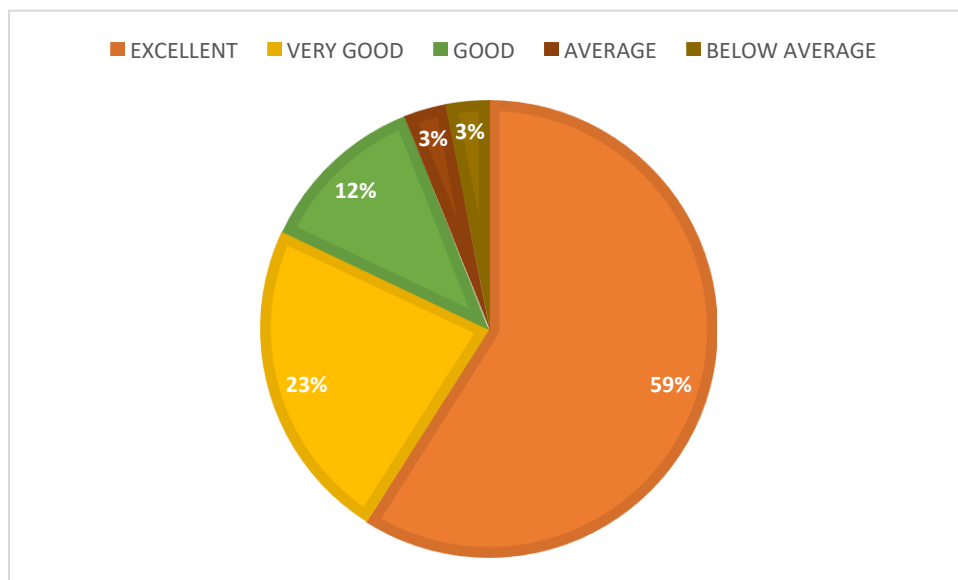
Applicable to Practical life

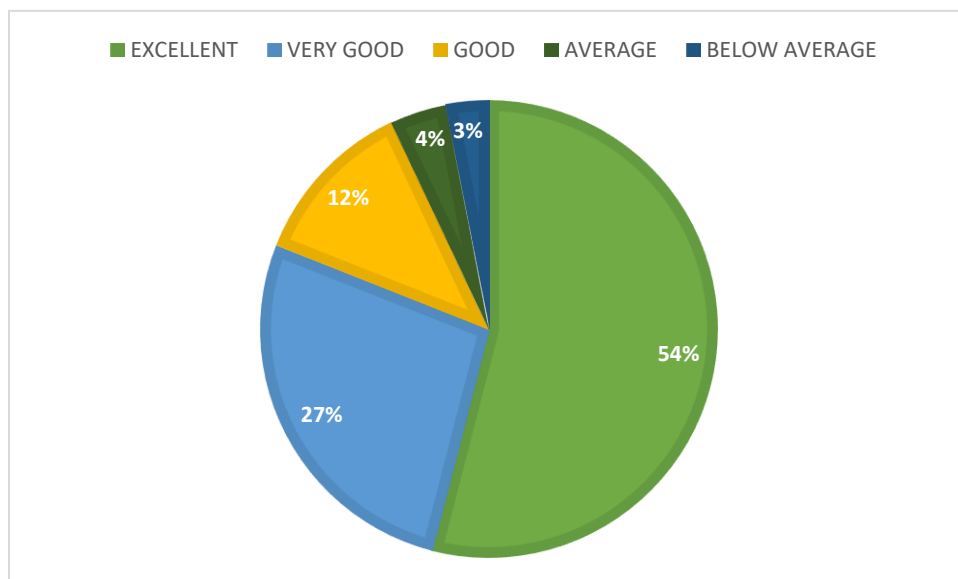
