

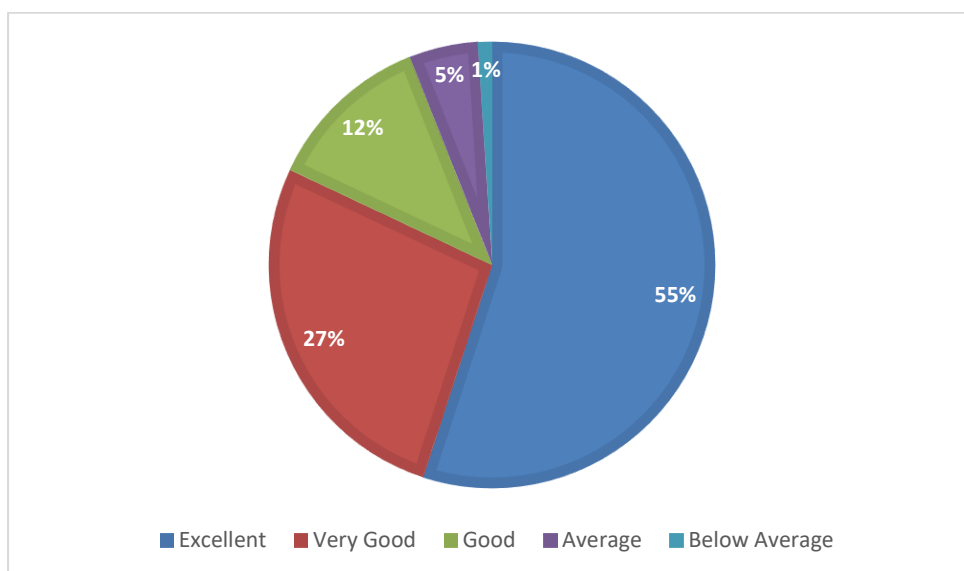

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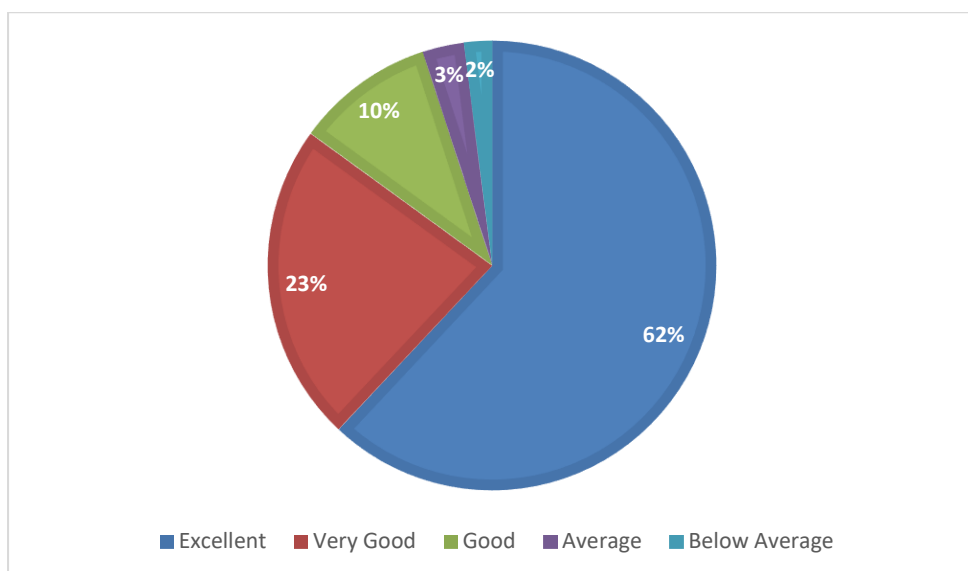
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2019-20 (Q2)

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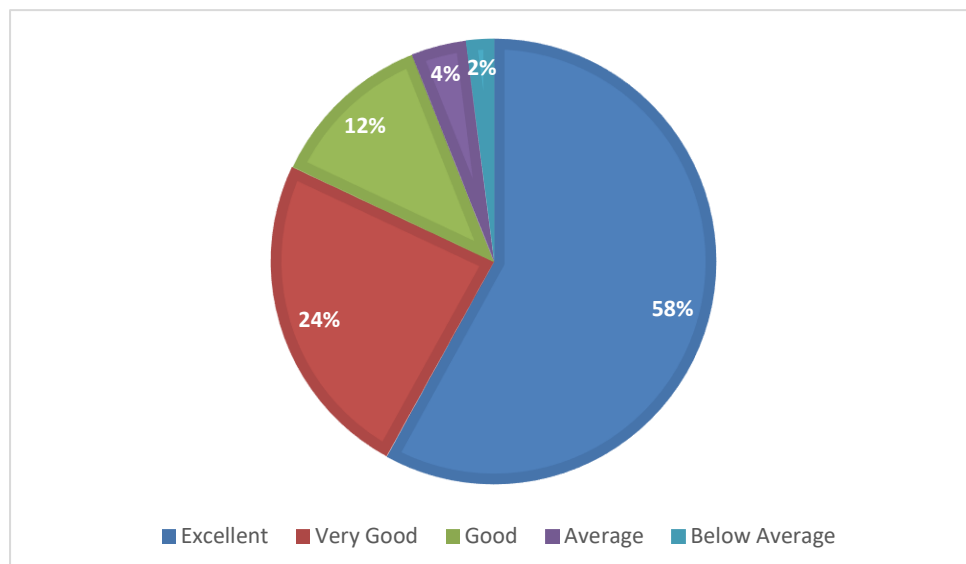
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2019-20 (Q3)

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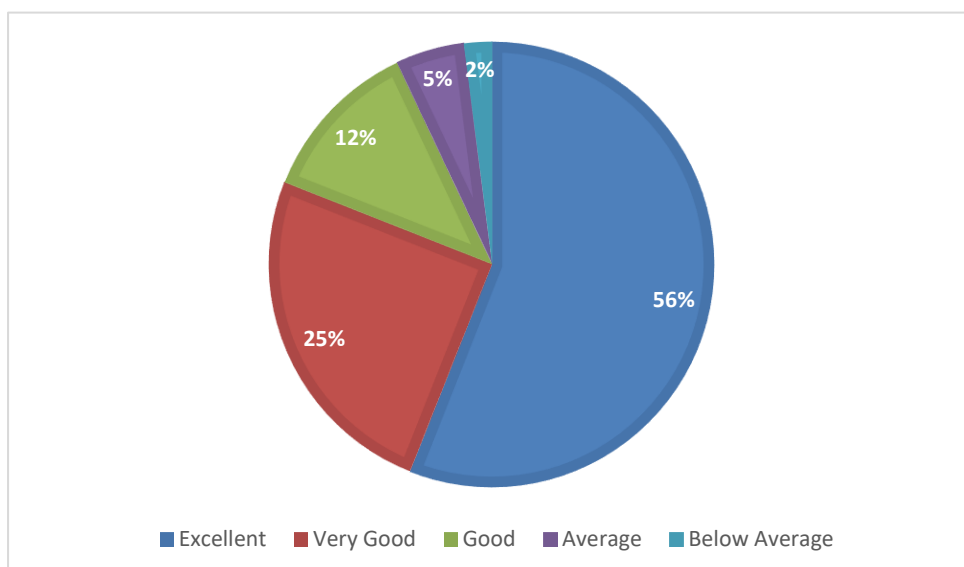
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2019-20 (Q4)

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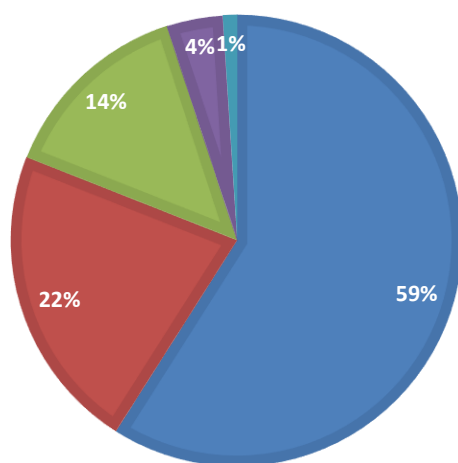

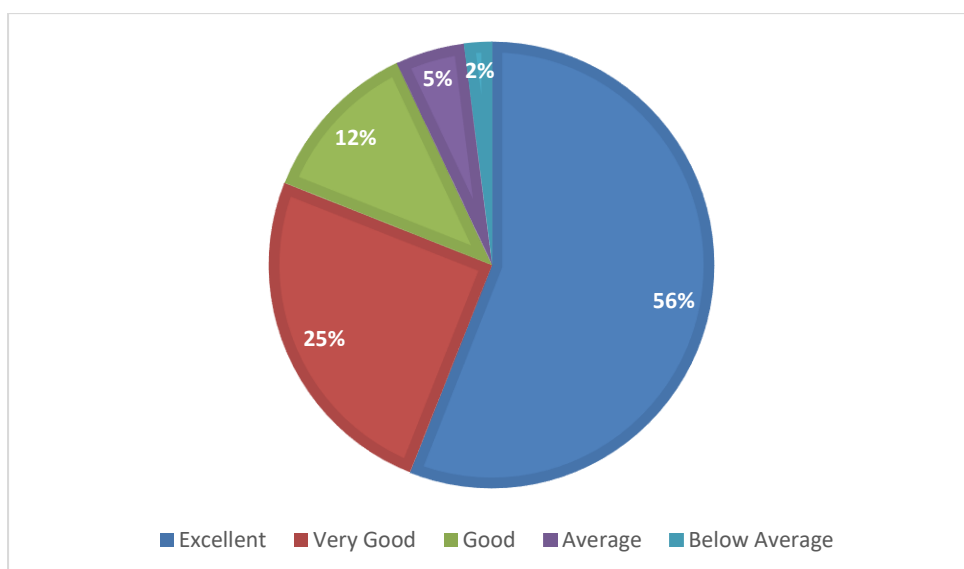
