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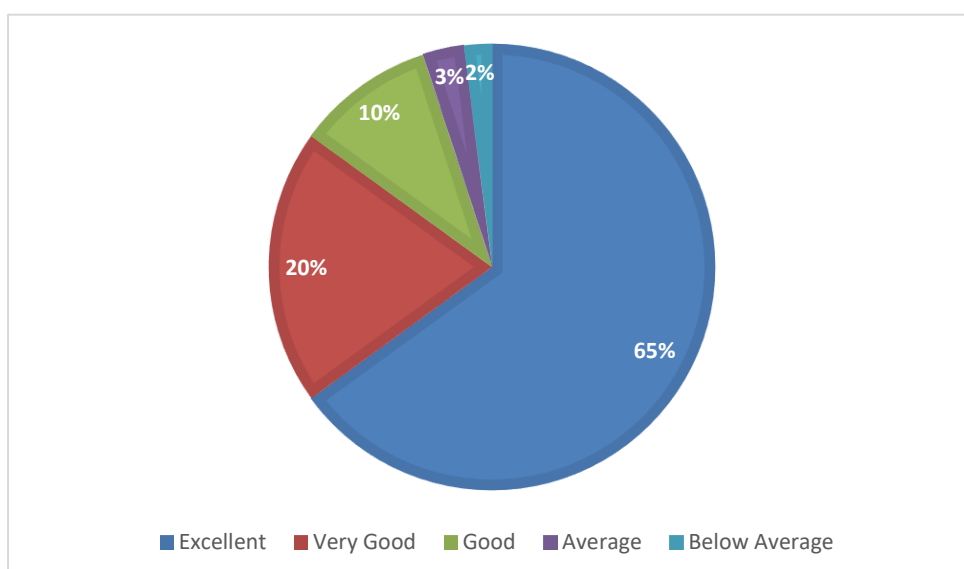

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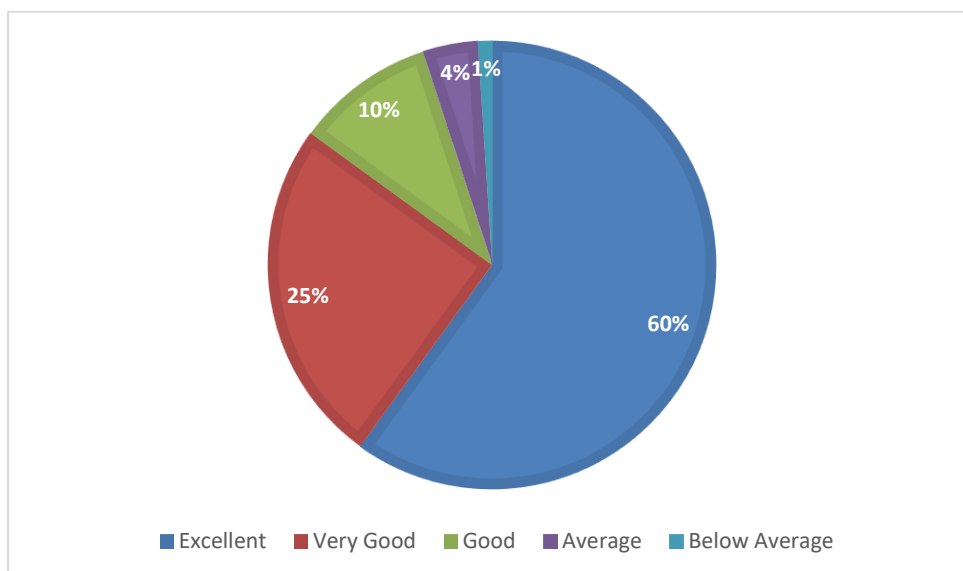

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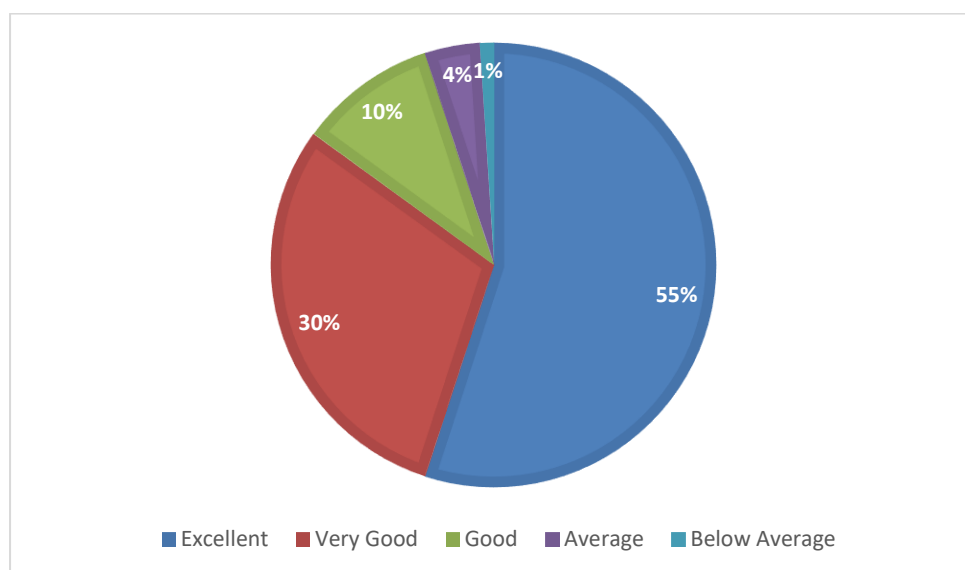

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underscores that the curriculum is successful in equipping employees with the skills and knowledge necessary for employment.



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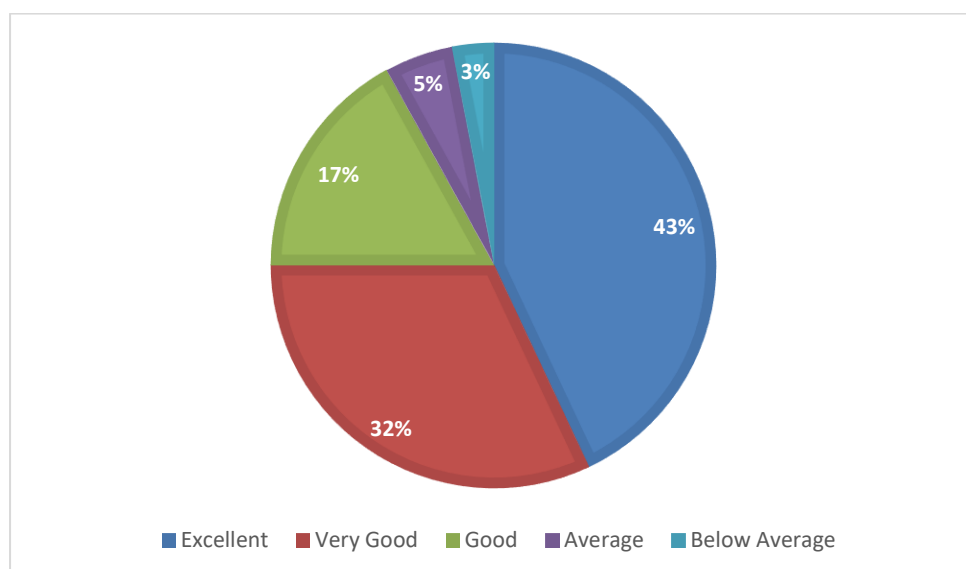

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positive, there is some room for improvement. This feedback highlights that the curriculum is largely effective in developing the intellectual capabilities of employees.



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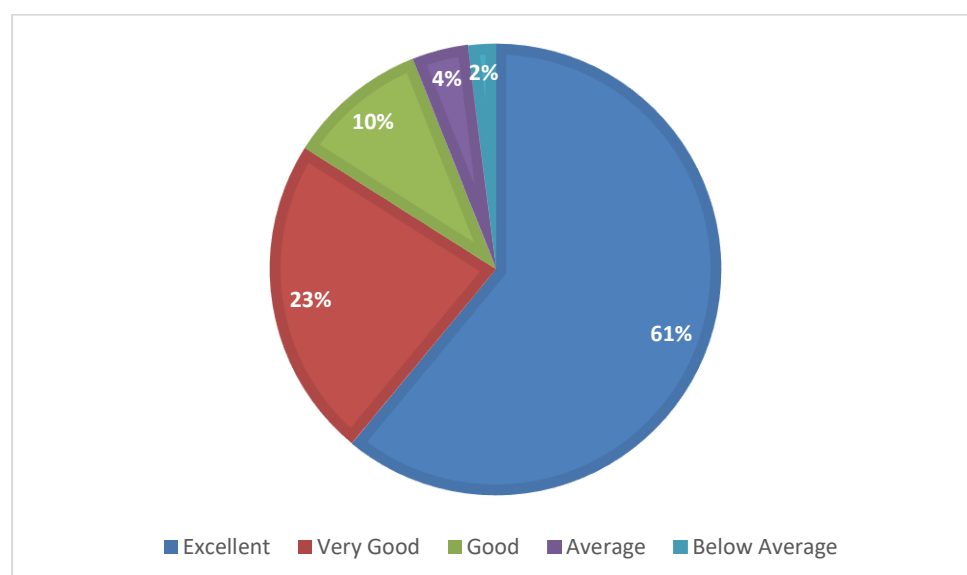

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scope for improvement. This feedback underscores that the curriculum is successful in equipping employees with the skills needed to effectively manage and resolve social and personal issues.



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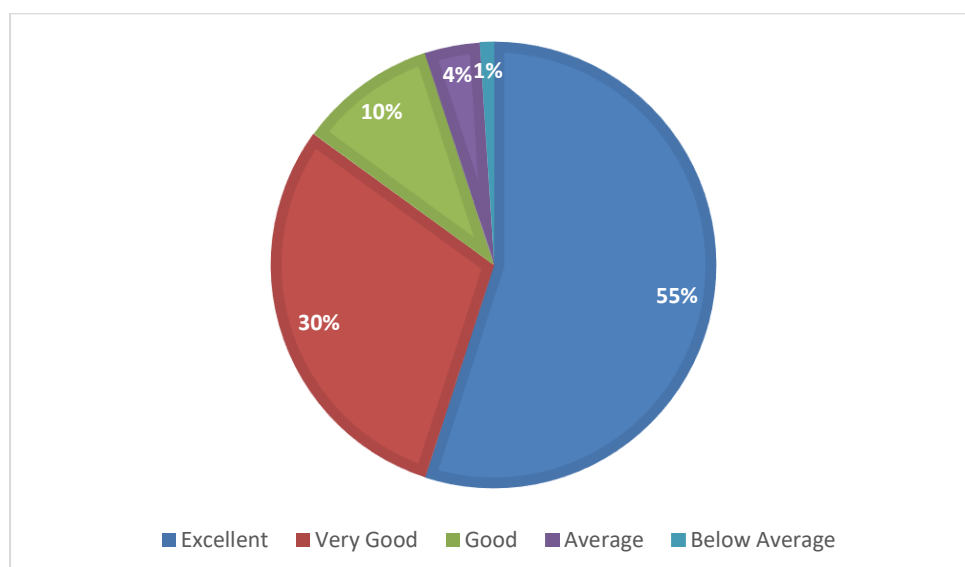
