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PRAGATHI SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The scholarship policy is designed to recognize and reward students who demonstrate exceptional academic activity, leadership qualities, active participation, and high attendance percentage. Eligibility criteria include demonstrating leadership qualities through extracurricular activities or community service, and maintaining a minimum attendance percentage. The selection process considers academic performance, leadership qualities, and participation, with scholarships offering benefits such as tuition fee waivers, financial stipends, and access to additional academic resources. Scholarships are awarded for specific academic periods and may be renewed based on continued eligibility and demonstration of active participation and leadership. The application process includes submitting an application, letters of recommendation, and personal statements. The policy emphasizes transparent decision-making, timely communication of outcomes, ongoing monitoring of recipients, and periodic review and revision to ensure alignment with institutional goals and values. The scholarship policy has been implemented starting from academic year 2017. All new and continuing students are eligible to apply for scholarships under this policy.
