Implementation Plan

Phase 1: 2024-2026

Establish the Schools of Social Science, Media Studies, Law, and Management. Initiate collaborations with at least five international universities. Launch the Alumni Association and start organizing networking events. Begin infrastructure upgrades, focusing on modernizing classrooms and building the research center. Implement the first batch of startups through the incubation center.

Phase 2: 2026-2028

Expand the Center for Research and Analysis and initiate more interdisciplinary research projects. Strengthen international collaborations by increasing student exchange programs and joint research publications. Complete the construction of hostels and the social center. Enhance the infrastructure for the Academy of IAS, IPS & IFS, providing comprehensive training resources.

Phase 3: 2028-2030

Fully operationalize the Center for International Studies with a diverse range of global programs. Increase the number of international research publications by 50%. Establish partnerships with leading industries through ASAP and KELTRON for advanced skill development courses. Conduct annual reviews and updates of strategic goals to ensure alignment with global educational standards and industry needs.
