

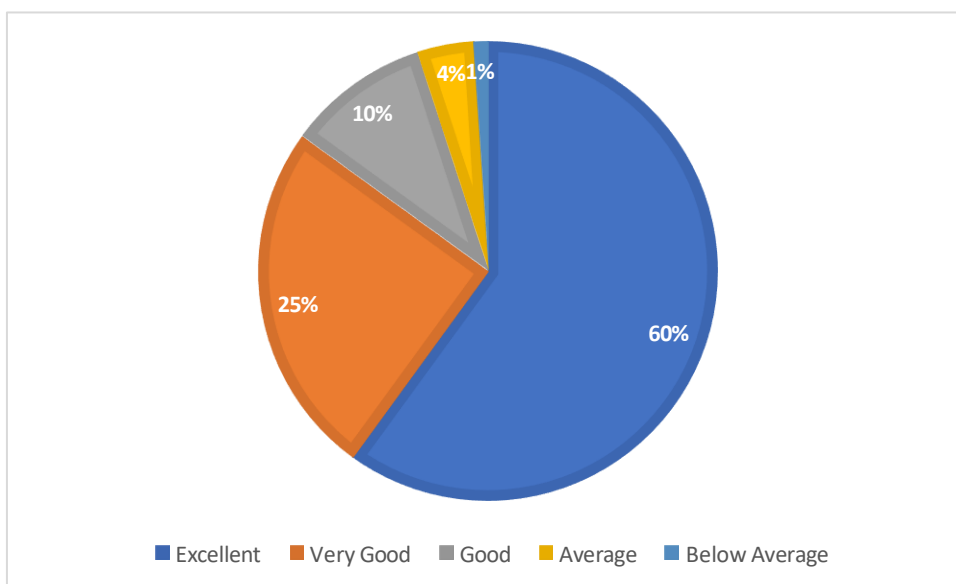


STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2020-21

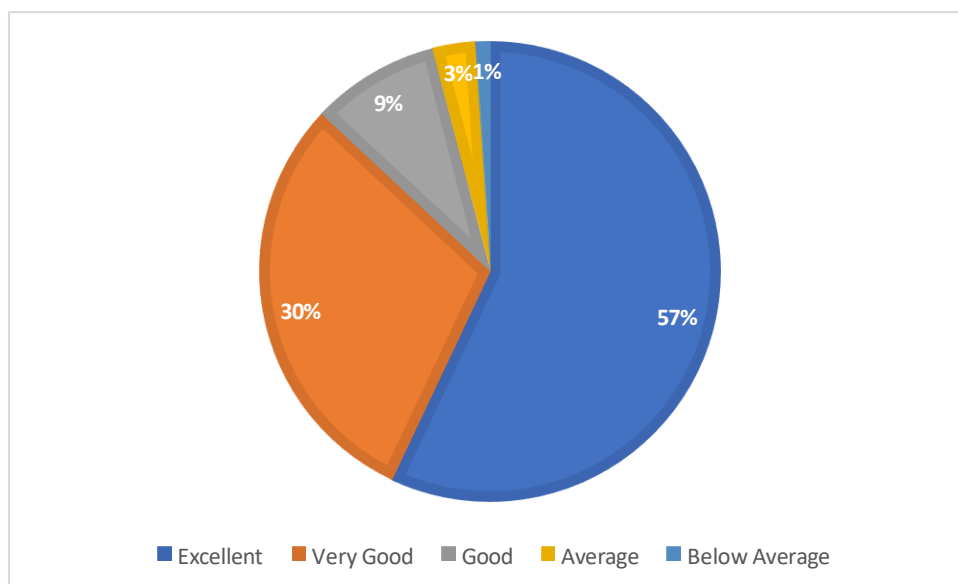

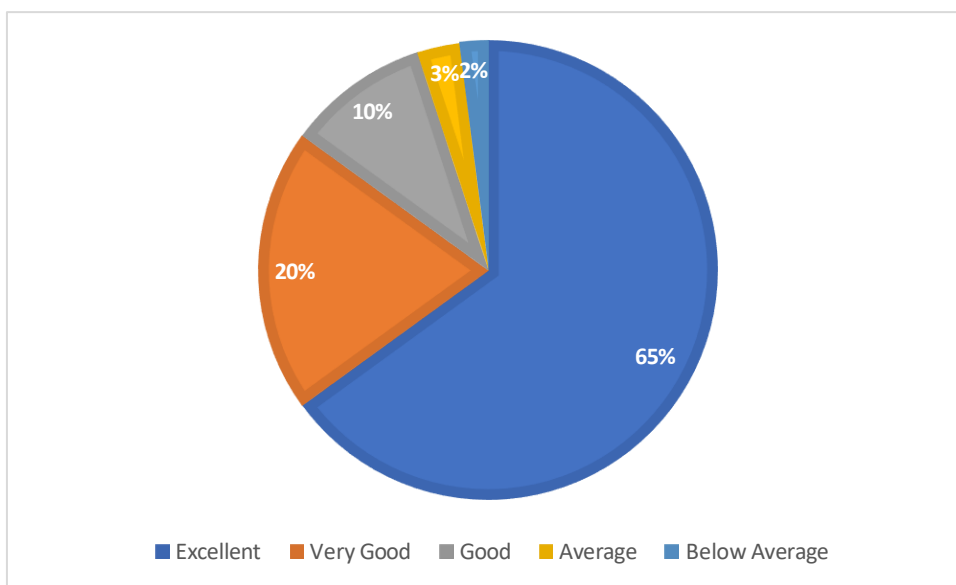

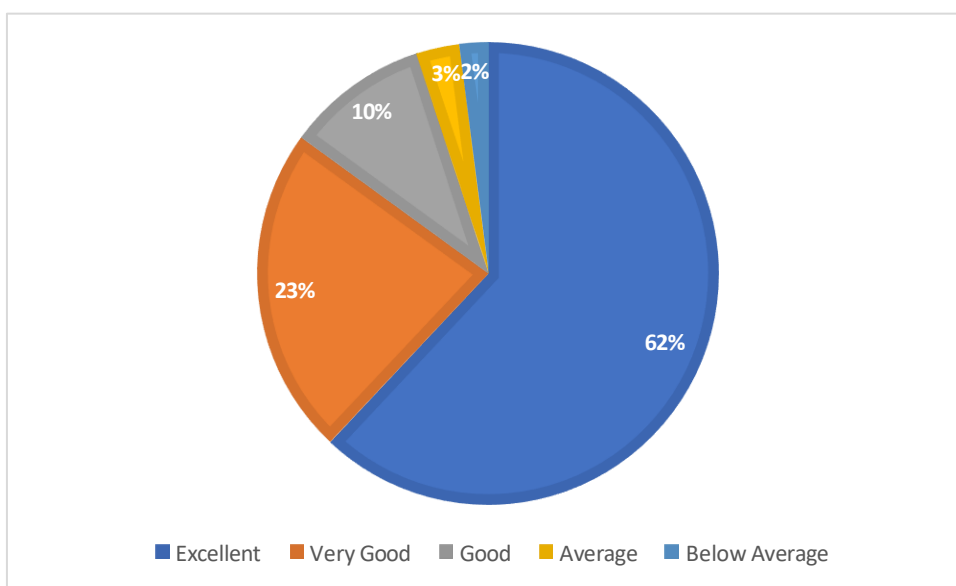

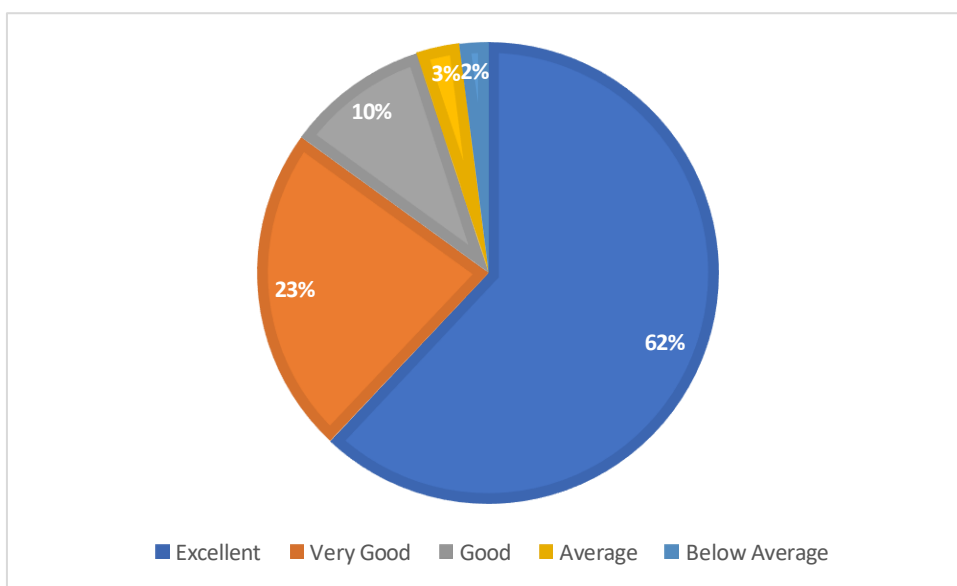

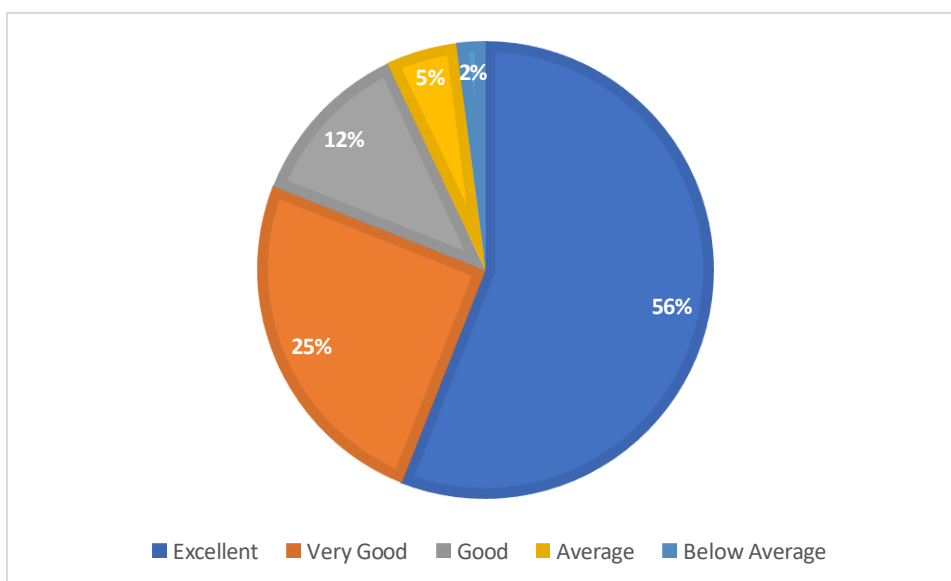

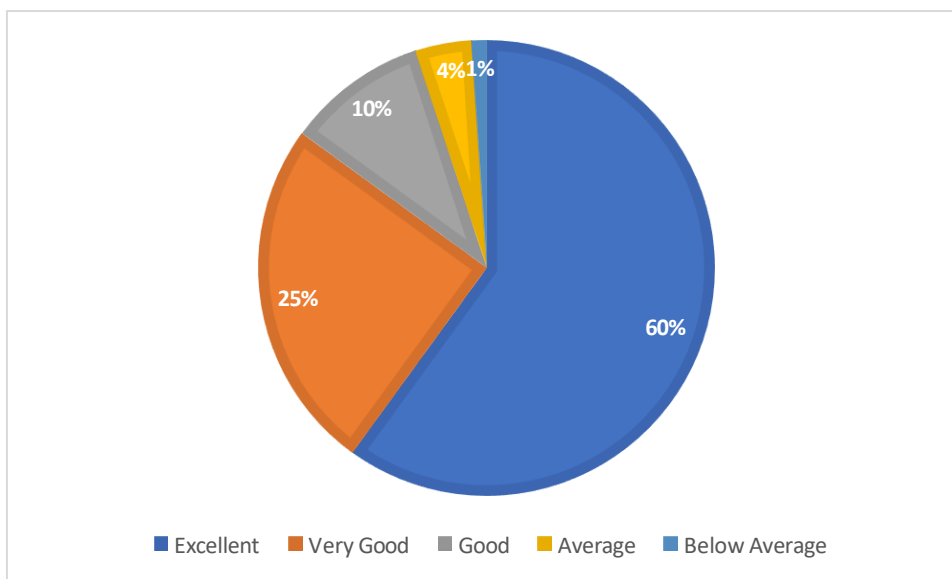

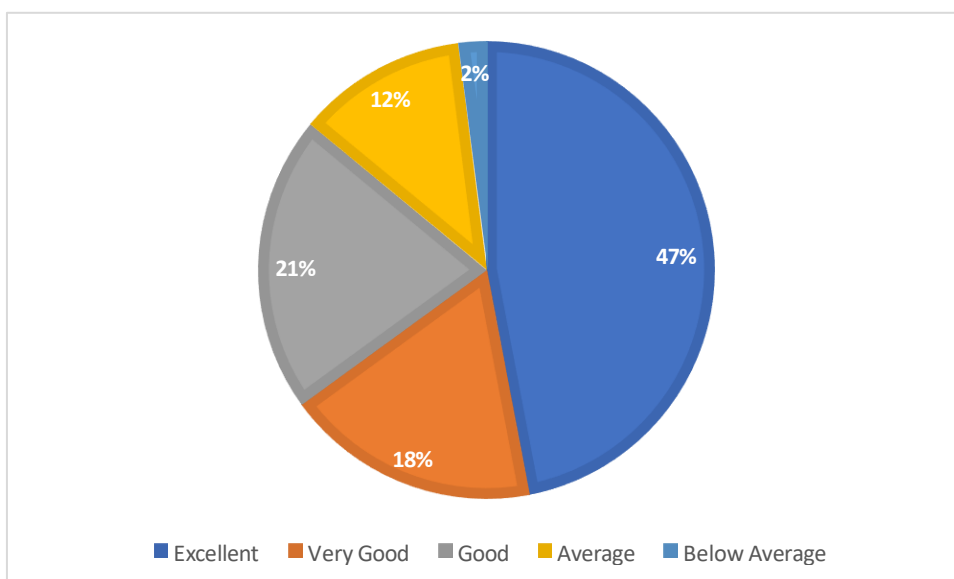

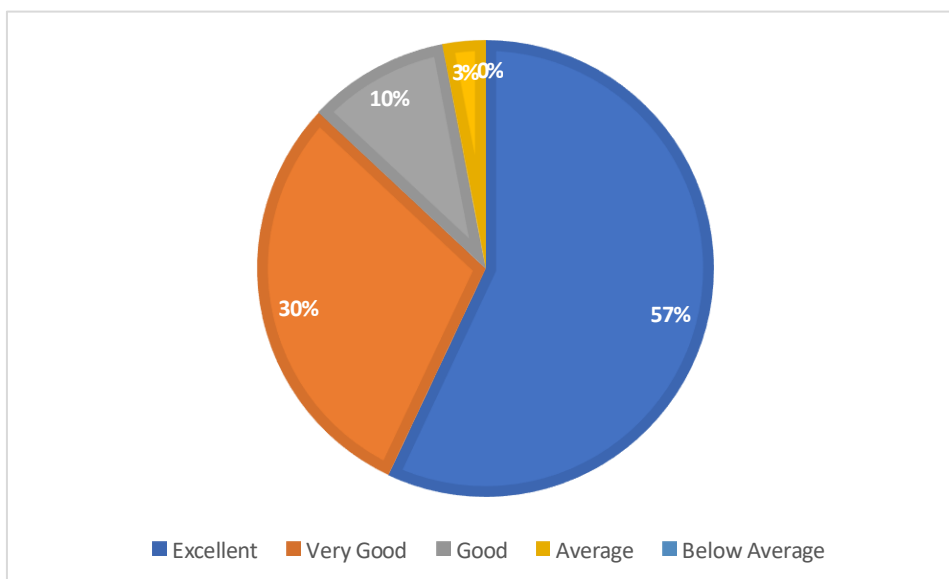
