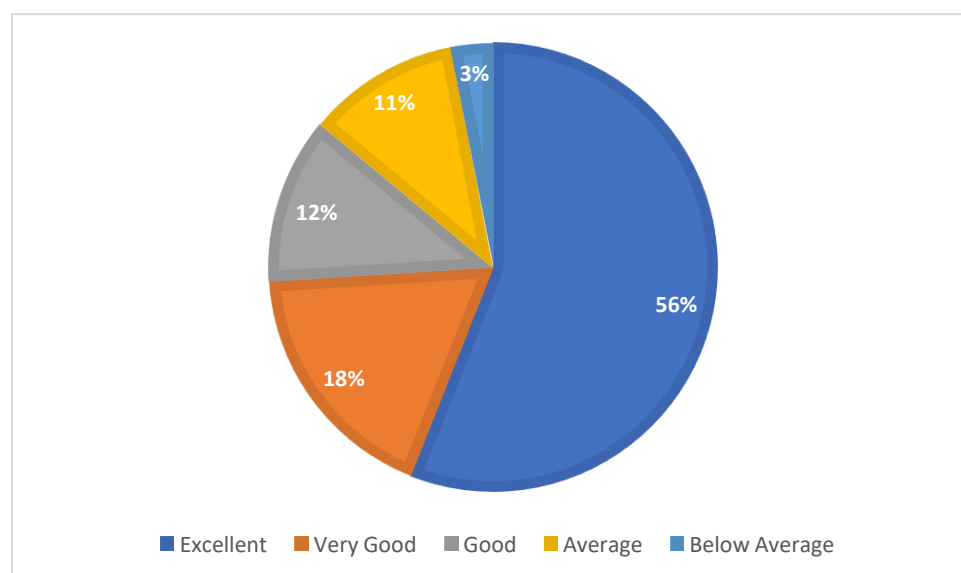

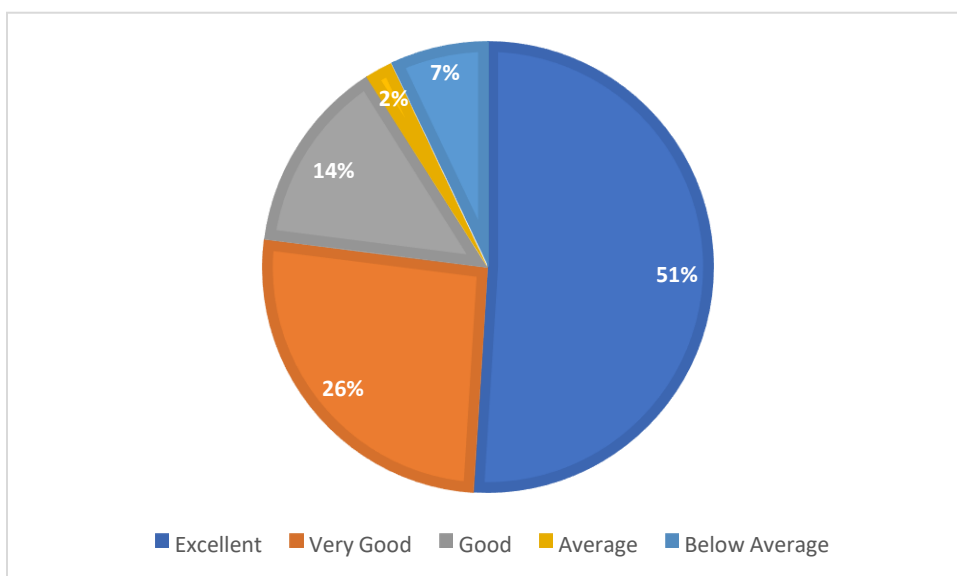

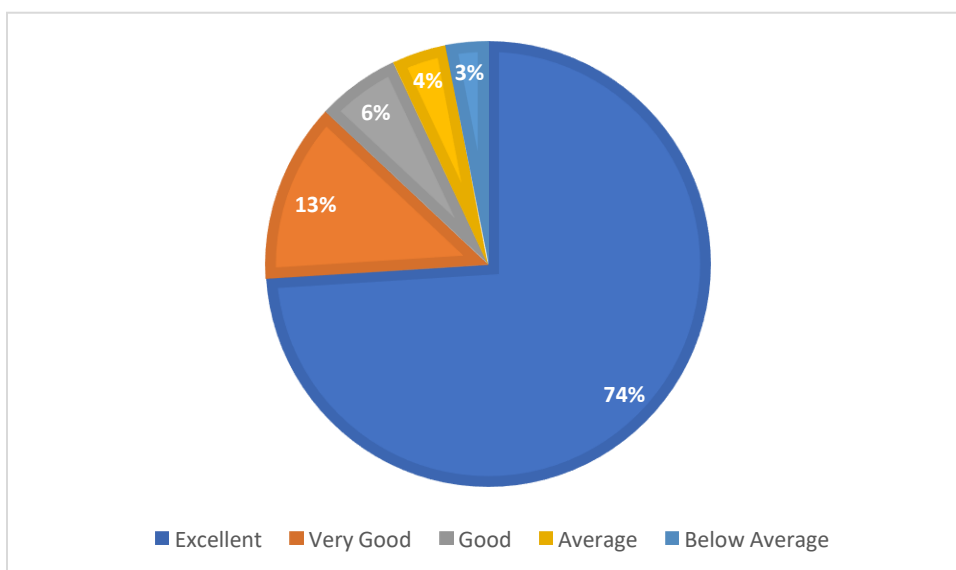

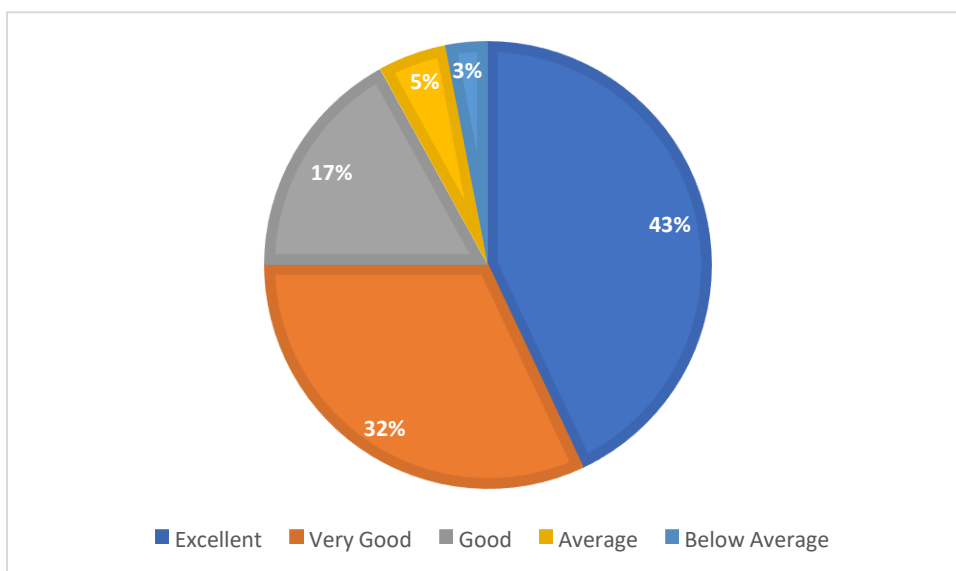

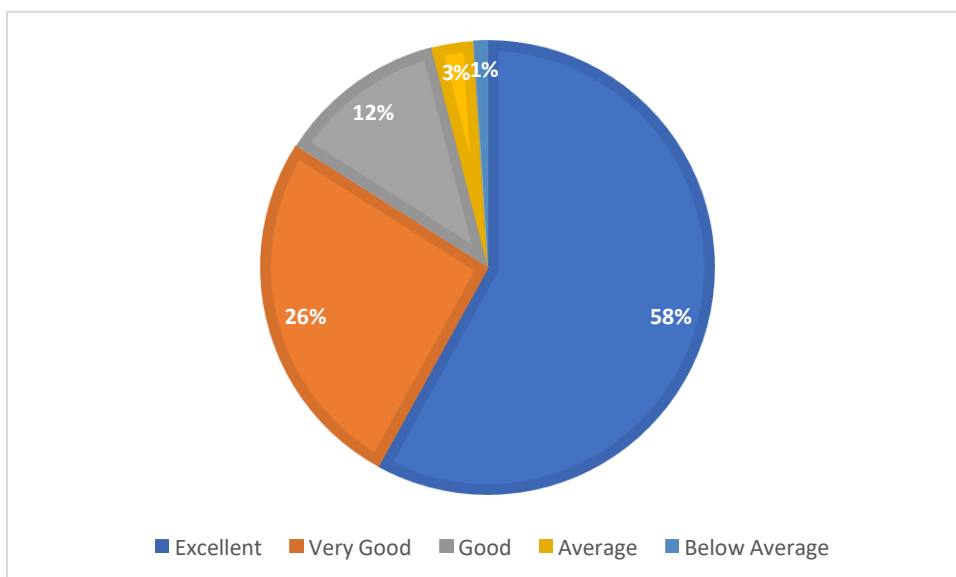

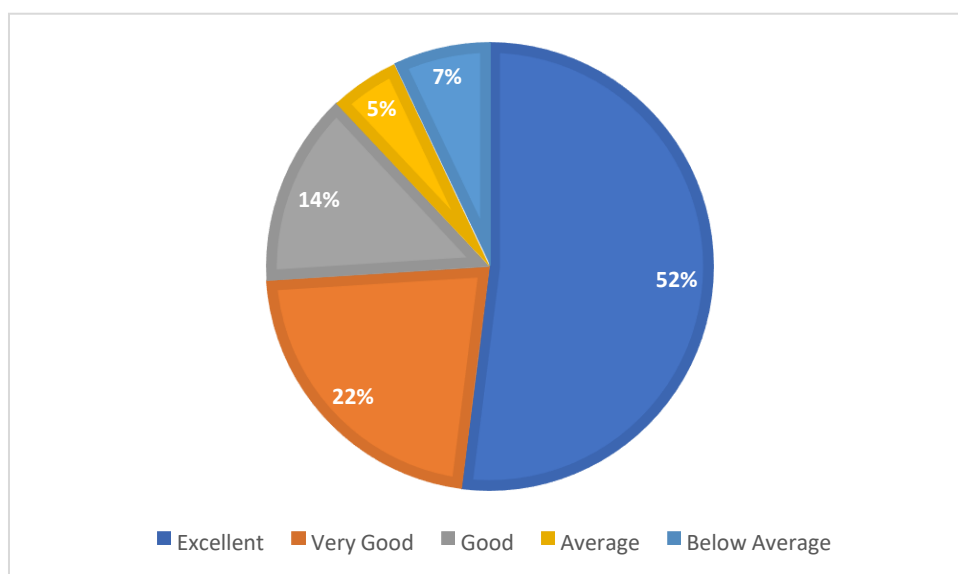

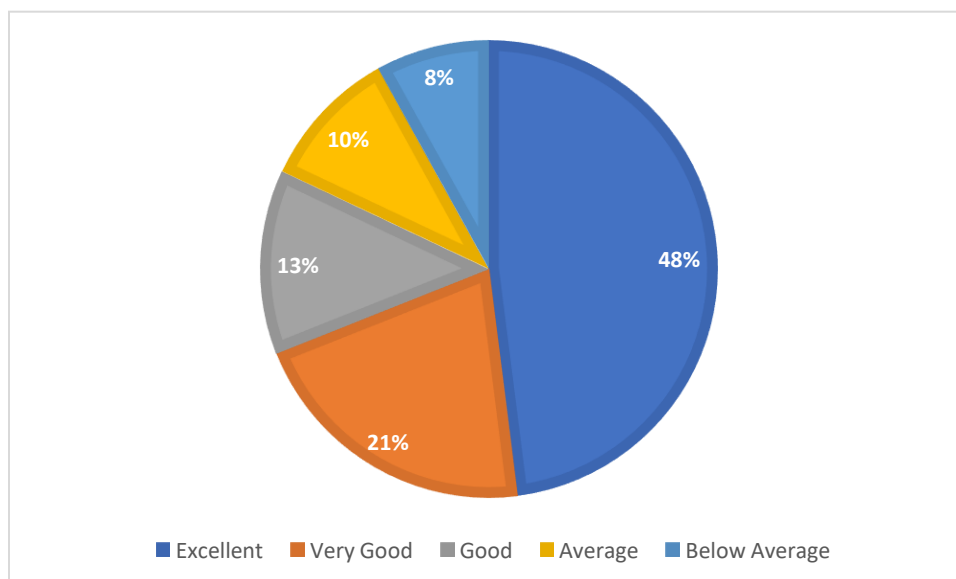

48%	21%	13%	10%	8%



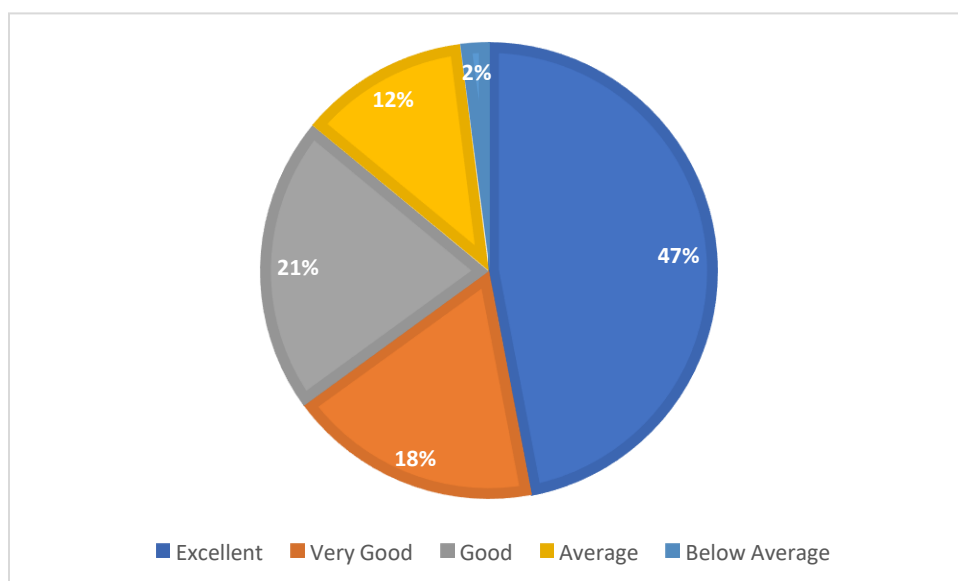

47%	18%	21%	12%	2%

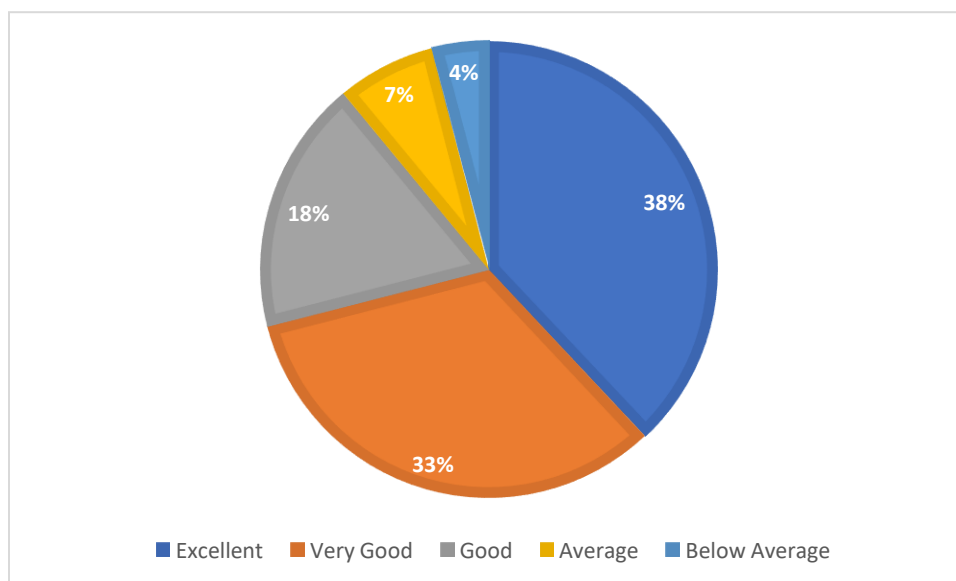
