As the new school year approaches, the legacy of the water pots project will continue to inspire students to seek out ways to make a positive difference in the world around them, one small act of kindness at a time.



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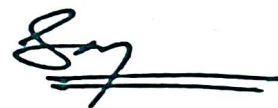
