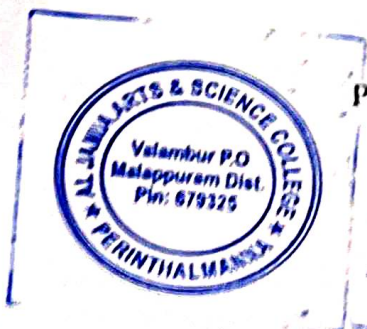

SURVEY ON COMMUNITY DISEASES AT ANGADIPPURAM PANCHAYATH

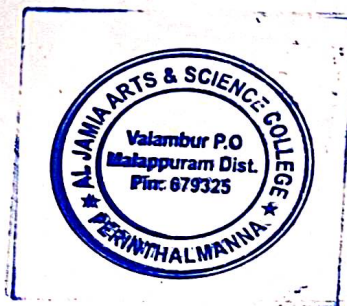

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Key findings from the survey highlighted significant aspects of community health:

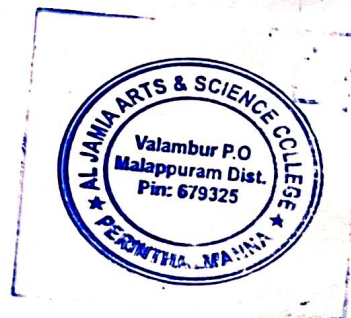
1. **Disease Prevalence:** Insights were gathered on the types of diseases prevalent in the area, including both communicable and non-communicable illnesses.

4. **Demographic Analysis:** Data collected offered demographic profiles of households surveyed, contributing to understanding health disparities across different demographics.



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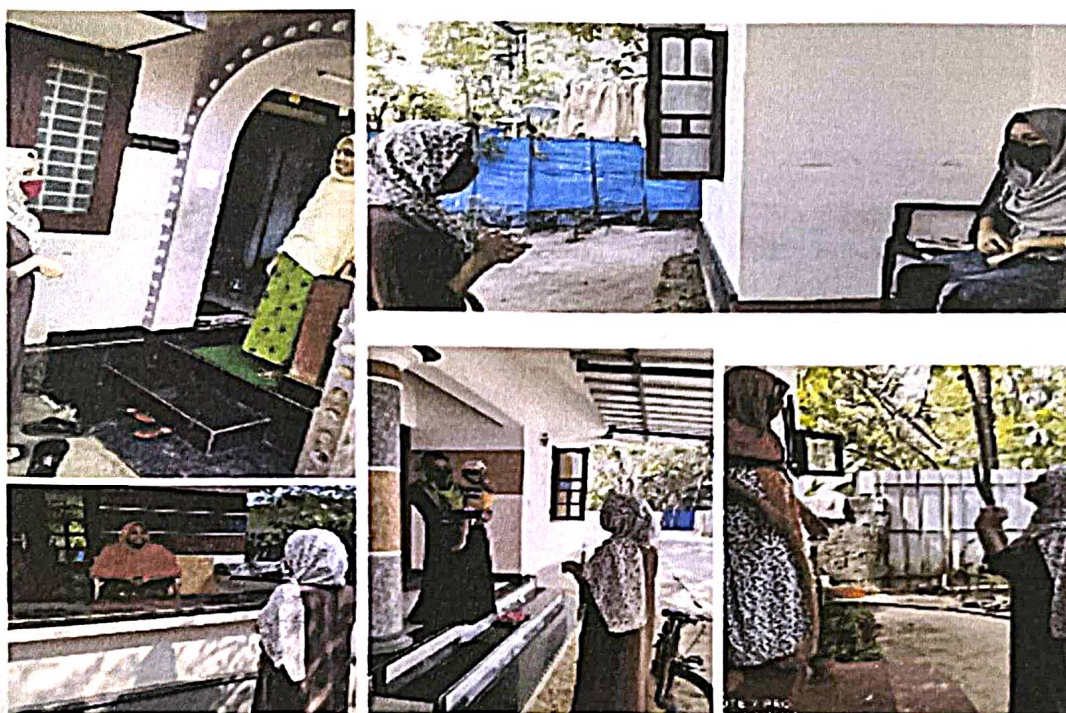

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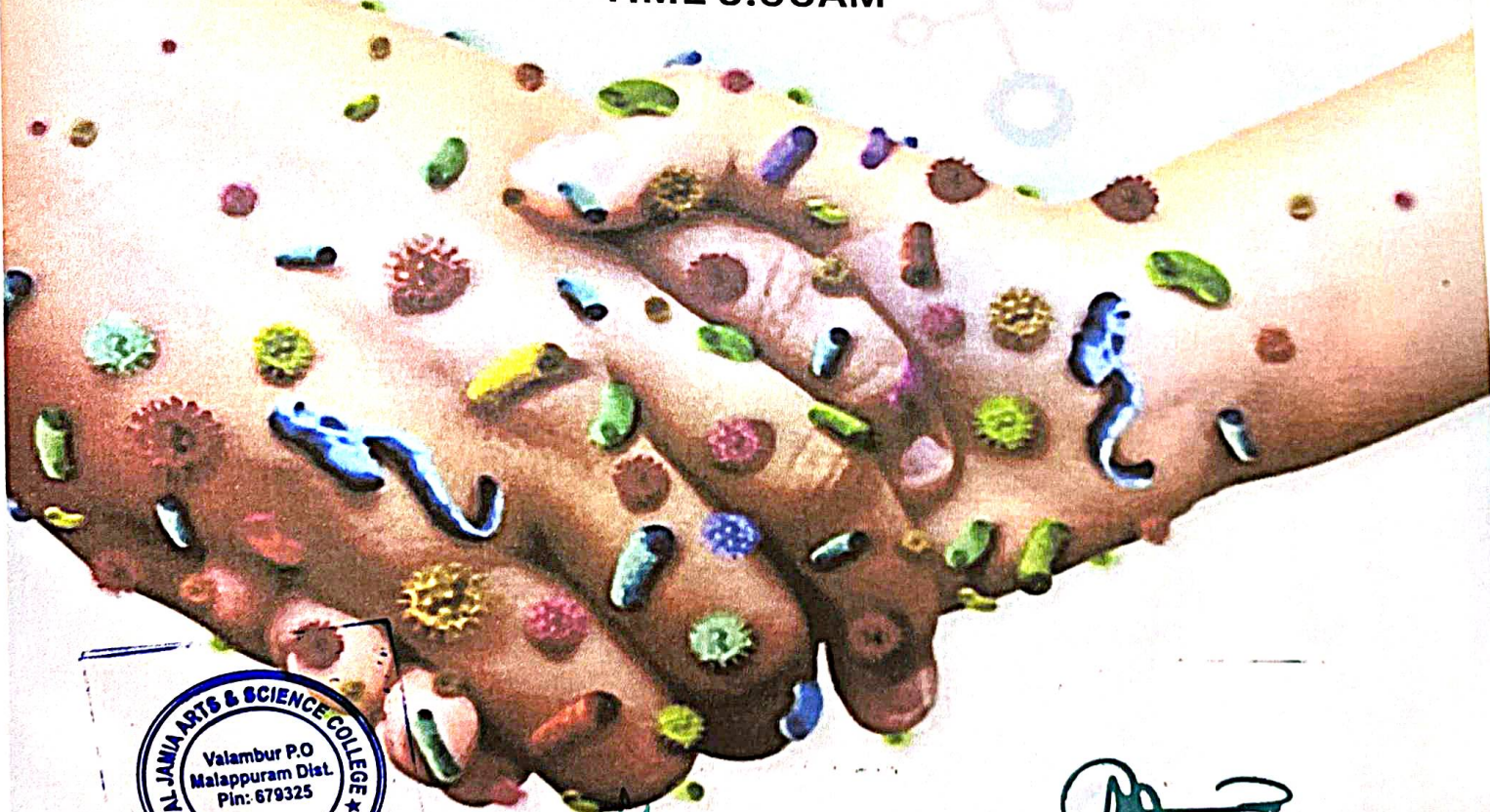
