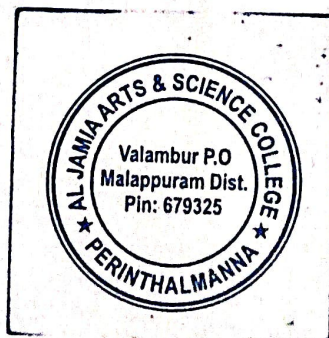
CIRCULAR

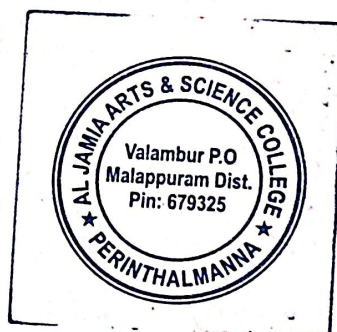

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PROGRAM REPORT

Gandhi Smrithi 2025 – Gandhi Jayanthi Celebration at Karayil Sadgramam

The program was conducted on 2nd October 2025, from 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM, at Karayil Sadgramam, Perinthalmanna. 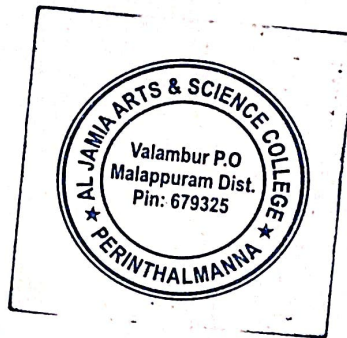

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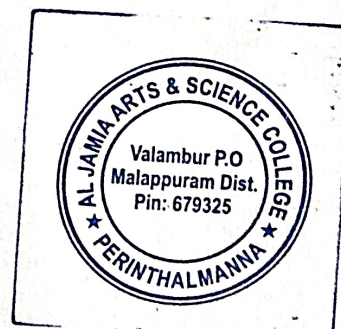

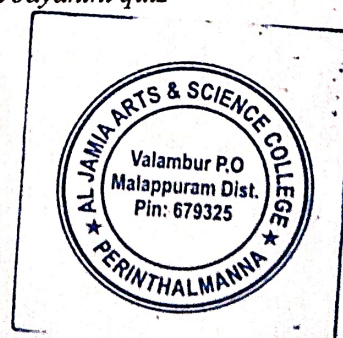
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NSS volunteer performing song on Gandhi



Prize distribution of Gandhi Jayanthi quiz



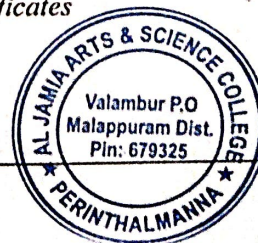

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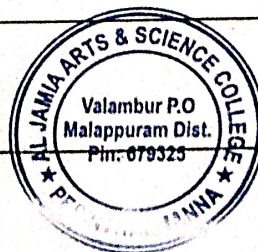
