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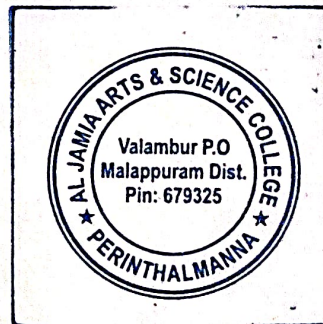

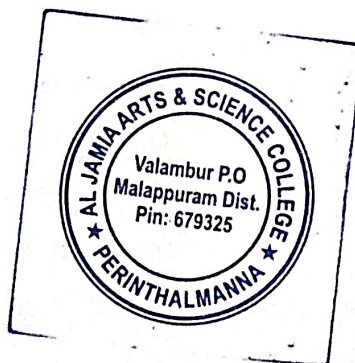

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PROGRAM REPORT

Gandhi Smrithi 2025-Cleaning Drive

As part of the nationwide Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and in remembrance of the 156th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, a dedicated cleaning drive was organized on October 2, 2025, under the banner of Gandhi Smrithi 2025. The program was held at the District Government Hospital, Perinthalmanna, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM. This meaningful initiative was conducted under the Sadgramam Project of the Perinthalmanna Constituency MLA, with active participation and support from the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Al Jamia Arts & Science College, Perinthalmanna. The event was organized to promote cleanliness, environmental responsibility, and community welfare in line with Gandhiji's ideals of hygiene and social service.

The program commenced promptly at 9:00 AM in the hospital courtyard with an inaugural session. The event was officially inaugurated by the Medical Officer of the District Government Hospital, Perinthalmanna, who emphasized the importance of cleanliness in healthcare spaces and the role of collective community efforts in maintaining public hygiene. In her inaugural address, the Medical Officer appreciated the initiative taken by the Sadgramam Project and the NSS volunteers in choosing the hospital premises for such a meaningful activity, stating that "clean surroundings are the first step toward healthy living."

Following the inauguration, the Staff Secretary of the District Government Hospital delivered a brief felicitation speech. He expressed gratitude to the organizing team and highlighted the necessity of continuous cleanliness drives to ensure a hygienic environment for patients and healthcare workers alike. The Nursing Superintendent of the hospital also addressed the gathering, providing detailed guidance and safety instructions to the volunteers regarding waste segregation, proper handling of cleaning materials, and adherence to hygiene protocols during the drive.

The cleaning drive saw the enthusiastic participation of 30 NSS volunteers from Al Jamia Arts & Science College, who arrived at the site early in the morning equipped with cleaning tools, gloves, masks, and other essential materials. The team was efficiently led by Ms. Praseetha, the Sadgramam Project Coordinator, and Mr. Shameem A.P., the NSS Program Officer of Al Jamia College. The volunteers were divided into smaller groups, each assigned to specific areas of the hospital premises, including the outpatient section, parking area, garden, corridors, and waste disposal zones. Under the guidance of the hospital staff and coordinators, the volunteers undertook systematic cleaning activities such as sweeping, waste collection, removal of plastic litter, and the arrangement of waste bins in designated areas. Efforts were also made to clean and beautify the hospital garden, where volunteers planted a few saplings as a tribute to Mahatma Gandhi's vision of a green and clean India.

One of the notable highlights of the event was the visit of Honourable MLA Mr. Najeeb Kanthapuram, who took time to interact with the volunteers and the organizing team. His presence added great encouragement to the participants. Addressing the volunteers, he lauded their commitment to social service and reaffirmed that initiatives like these uphold the true spirit of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. He also reiterated the vision of the Sadgramam Project, which aims to promote community-driven developmental activities across Perinthalmanna constituency.

The MLA's visit created a positive impact, motivating the young volunteers to continue engaging in similar socially responsible endeavors in the future. His words of appreciation were warmly received by everyone present, and he extended best wishes to the NSS team and the hospital authorities for their cooperation.

The cleaning drive was carried out meticulously over three hours. Volunteers demonstrated discipline, teamwork, and dedication throughout the program. Collected waste materials were properly segregated into biodegradable and non-biodegradable categories before being handed over to the municipal waste management team for proper disposal. Special attention was given to maintaining cleanliness around patient care areas and public waiting zones to minimize disruption to hospital operations.

By the end of the drive, the hospital surroundings reflected a visible improvement in cleanliness and orderliness. The hospital authorities expressed immense satisfaction with the work

done, noting that such efforts create awareness among both staff and the general public about the importance of maintaining hygiene within healthcare facilities.

Beyond the physical act of cleaning, the program served as a symbolic reaffirmation of Gandhiji's message—that cleanliness is not just a personal responsibility but a collective social duty. Volunteers shared their reflections after the event, expressing that the activity deepened their sense of civic consciousness and environmental awareness. It also strengthened their understanding of the NSS motto, "Not Me, But You."

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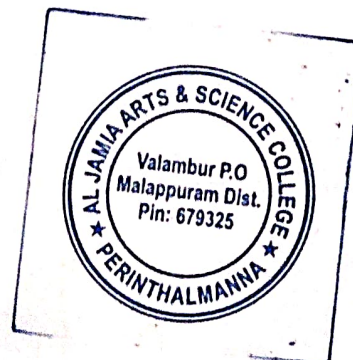

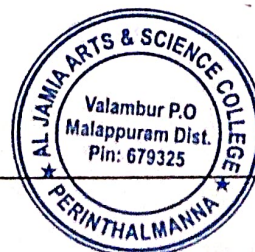

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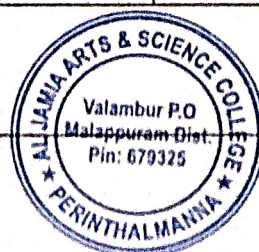
