PROGRAMME REPORT

OUTREACH PROGRAMME – GROWING WITH ENGLISH

The Department of English, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), conducted an outreach programme “Growing With English” at No. 26 GLP School, Pooppalam (Anganwadi) on 9th February 2026 (Monday). The initiative aimed to foster English language awareness among young learners and their families, underscoring the vital role of English in early education. By highlighting its benefits for communication skills, future opportunities, and cultural bridging in a diverse society, the programme sought to engage children through interactive, age-appropriate activities while reinforcing the department's commitment to community engagement and early literacy development.

The event commenced at 2:00 PM with a welcome speech by Mrs. Fathima Muneeba, Assistant Professor, Department of English. Her address set an enthusiastic tone, outlining the programme's goals and expressing gratitude to the school staff, parents, and participants. This was followed by an awareness talk for parents, delivered by Fathima Saja, a second-year BA English student on the topic “Importance of English in Education”. She explained the significance of early English exposure, emphasizing how it enhances communication abilities, unlocks academic and career prospects, and promotes inclusivity in multicultural settings. In



her own words, she stated, "Parenting in today's world means guiding children with love and balance—valuing education and English, understanding their struggles, preparing them for a competitive future, giving support instead of pressure so they grow up confident, kind, and ready for life."

Following the talk, interactive activities tailored to the young learners were led by a total of 9 students from the Department of English. These sessions made learning playful and memorable, sparking curiosity about English through hands-on engagement. The 1st-year students led Colour Cubes and Emotion Recognition activities, helping the learners associate basic vocabulary with visual cues. The 2nd-year students facilitated Basic Words and Colour Recognition games, building foundational language skills through repetition and fun challenges. The 3rd-year students organized Simon Says and Rhyme Action sessions, encouraging listening, movement, and rhythmic language play. The activities were inclusive, with both the young participants and their families involved, creating a vibrant atmosphere of laughter and learning.

The programme concluded at 3:30 PM with a vote of thanks by Ms. Alisha Shereef, Assistant Professor, Department of English. She appreciated the contributions of all volunteers, the Anganwadi's hospitality, and the enthusiastic response from children and parents, reiterating the department's dedication to such initiatives.

The outreach successfully engaged children, parents, and the school staff. Feedback highlighted the activities' effectiveness in making English accessible and enjoyable. This event not only promoted early literacy but also strengthened community ties, aligning with the department's broader goals of social responsibility and quality education outreach.
